

Changes to school bus 674 from Amesbury to the Laverstock Schools

from September 2018



From September 2018, school bus 674 to the Laverstock Schools is being replaced by a new bus service called **675** which will be run by the Salisbury Reds bus company as a commercial venture, without the involvement of Wiltshire Council.

The **675** bus will call at the same bus stops in Amesbury as the 674 but will now also serve the London Road and Bulford area as well, picking up at the following times:

To travel on the 675 bus, students from the Bulford and Amesbury area will need to purchase one of the following tickets:

Single (one way) ticket: £3.30 – purchase from the driver

Day Return Ticket: £4.60 – purchase from the driver

Termly Scholars Pass: Autumn Term = £302.20, Spring Term = £248.40, Summer Term = £256.70

Please note that the Scholars pass will need to be purchased in advance from the Salisbury Reds Travel Shop on New Canal in Salisbury, or during August from the Go South Coast bus pass website at: passes.gosouthcoast.co.uk .

The scholars pass will be valid for travel on the 675 bus and also on the public bus services X4 and X5 between Bulford / Amesbury and Salisbury, and on buses operating between Salisbury City Centre and Laverstock. However the pass can only be used for travel to/from school during term time (not at weekends or during the school holidays).

Please note that Saver tickets, Network tickets or Keycards will not be accepted to travel on bus service 675.
