Roles available:

KS3 Senior Girl

Responsibilities:

Responsibilities:

- Acting as ambassadors on subject consultation evenings and other key events in the school calendar
- Performing specific duties as required to help support other students and events.
- To attend regular meetings as required.
- To model the high expectations required of a student of St Edmund's in all aspects of school life.

Pastoral Prefects

A team of twelve students with responsibility for:

- To act as mentors to year 7 students during their transition period.
- To support the work of the senior pastoral prefects in supporting other students.
- To attend regular meetings as required.
- To model the high expectations required of a student of St Edmund's in all aspects of school life.

How to apply

Write a letter of application for the roles or roles that you would like to be considered for.

Ideally word process your letter.

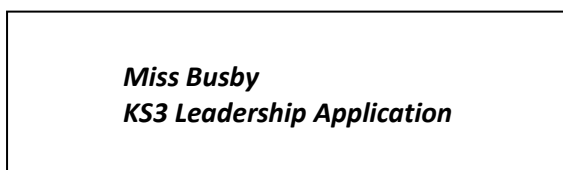
Your letter should be no more than one side of A4.

Include in your letter:

- Why you would like to be considered
- What qualities and skills you have or are trying to develop
- Evidence that supports that you are working towards developing your skills
- Any relevant experience that supports what you are saying
- -for example: if you want to demonstrate that you show commitment talk about a club you have been involved for a period of time or a qualification or activity that you have stuck with.
- Any creative ideas you would bring to the team (be realistic!)

Your letter should be addressed to Miss Busby.

Write (or print) your letter and put it into an envelope marked like this:



Hand your envelope in at Reception by 1.00 p.m. on Friday 23rd June.

Remember to write your own letter but ask someone to proof read it.

You will be informed later that week of the process for selection.

Remember to ask the current team if you have any questions; they really won't mind helping you.
