



Dear Parents and Carers

If your daughter suffers from asthma, she should carry an inhaler with her at school. However, please note that **parents are also advised to supply spare inhalers available for use at school.**

Spare inhalers must be properly labelled with the student's name and they **must be in date**. Inhalers will be stored in the medical room cupboard and will be available as required, under the supervision of the First Aider in attendance.

If your daughter requires treatment with an inhaler, she may only use the inhaler that is specifically prescribed for her. **Asthma inhalers may not be shared, nor does the First Aid office keep 'spare' ones.**

Asthma can be a potentially serious condition and it is the parents' responsibility to ensure that the school protocol regarding the use of inhalers is followed.
