Dear Parent/Carer

St Edmund's will be holding end of year exams for all year groups this term.

Exam content could cover anything taught between September 2017 and June 2018, so please encourage your daughter to use her exercise book to revise her learning from this year. End of year exams are an important part of how we assess students and will be reflected in the end of year reports. The results will help us identify who is on track, who needs extra support, who copes well with exams and who may need further coaching and advice in the autumn term. We are urging students to treat these exams with the utmost importance; to revise for them properly at home (advice on revising will be given in lessons) so that we can fully measure their progress.

Students in years 7, 8 and 9 will sit most exams in lessons between 18th June and 6th July and their teachers will confirm with students exactly when each exam will be. Some exams for these years will be held in the hall/gym to give students an experience of formal exams. Students in year 10 will sit most exams in the hall/gym (only some in lessons) between 18th June and 29th June in order to experience a full exam timetable in preparation for next year.

The following exams will be held in the main hall/gym:

Year 7

Friday 6th July – Maths

Year 8

Monday 2nd July – Maths

Year 9

Thursday 21st June – English Language (Paper 1)

Wednesday 27th June – English Language (Paper 2)

Monday 2nd July – Maths

Friday 6th July – Religious Studies

Year 10

Students will receive a separate exams timetable explaining when and where each exam will be held.
