Year 7 spent the day learning about climate change and how they can make a difference. They learnt about the importance of bees to our environment and the threat to their habitat before designing and constructing their own bug hotels. Students were fantastic throughout the day!



Year 8 completed the first day of their 3 day carousel with a STEM forensics day in school and two trips: a history trip to Hampton Court Palace and a geography fieldtrip to Salisbury to complete a GCSE task.




The STEM forensics day involved assessing a crime scene, fingerprinting, chemical flame tests, analysis and identification of hair and fibres, chromatography and blood spatter analysis.



Year 9 also completed the first day of their 3 day carousel with a GCSE Science practical day in school and two trips: a PE trip to Victoria Country Park and an RS trip to Medina Mosque in Southampton.
