- **Scholars will have skirts available to purchase** there and then, using either cash or bank card. **Note that you may receive a different style of skirt** (no pleats at the back and with a pocket). Scholars have notified us that they made an error when ordering new stock of the St Edmund's skirt. Although we are very disappointed, it has become apparent that there is no other option as there is not enough time for the factory to make enough before September. We have, therefore, had to accept this skirt and we will make a decision in consultation with students regarding which style skirt they prefer for the future.

End of the Summer Term

Lockers: please remind your daughter to clear her locker in good time before the end of term. Lockers are cleaned and re-allocated on an annual basis according to where girls have their tutor base. Girls often forget to empty their lockers for the summer but please note that **unfortunately we must dispose of any items left behind as we do not have storage facilities.** Please don't let this happen to your daughter's possessions; we hate having to throw anything away!
