Commentary

P8 Gap – down from 0.74 to 0.43. A8 Gap – down from 13.3pts to 9.8.

These figures represent approx. move from 90th percentile to 50th percentile nationally on gap data. A significant improvement.

P8 Gap English – grew slightly from 0.25 to 0.33.

P8 Gap Maths – down from 0.95 to 0.49 reflecting the targeted PPD work done. It is worth noting that P8, A8 and gap data all improved for PPD in maths overall.

Attendance statistics for disadvantaged learners

Nationally, disadvantaged students have higher rates of absence compared to non-disadvantaged students. Our attendance figures for disadvantaged students have improved significantly over the last 4 years:

- 2013-14 88.76%
- 2014-15 90.27%
- 2015-16 92.48% (national average 92.2%)
- 2016-17 92.24%
