Dear Parent or Carer,

You will remember my previous letter of 6.7.18 notifying you of our new Behaviour for Learning Policy. I have now conveyed to our students in assembly the premise of the policy and set out the expectations for September. The updated policy can be found on our website:

Although we are collaborating across campus, uniform for both schools will remain separate. The uniform is an important part of our character and parents/carers are expected to support the school in maintaining good appearance please. The details for both uniforms (and where they can be purchased) can be found within the Behaviour policy. Two specific points I'd like to highlight are:

- 1) **Shoes** must be black only, smart and must be polishable. The maximum heel height is 2". Sandals, canvas shoes, trainers, trainer-style shoes or shoes with logos are not acceptable. No boots are allowed except in severe weather conditions.
- 2) **Skirts** should be no shorter than 2 inches above the knee. The skirt must not be rolled up.

A reminder that the first day back for all students is Wednesday 5th September, with Years 8-11 arriving at 10.25 a.m. Please note that:

- No special school buses will be running to bring your child to school for 10.25 a.m., however they may use their bus pass on normal service routes.
- We understand that for a few students who live in outlying areas it is not possible to use normal service bus routes to get to school for 10.25 a.m. We will have provision at school for these students from 8.20 a.m., but please email my PA ccrook@st-edmunds.eu in advance to let us know if your child needs this provision.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank you for your continued commitment to ensuring that your daughter or son contributes to our school in a positive way. I am especially looking forward to a new term, and am anticipating a vibrant, thriving community.
