Key subject information (dates, revision sessions and other useful information):

Art and Photography – Art and Photography rooms are open to all year 11 students between 2.50-4pm every day of the week until 27th April for independent study, one-to-one support or extended work. <u>Collaboration Art and Photography exam dates – Mon 16th April and Wed 25th April (10hrs). Non-collaboration Art and Photography exam dates – Weds 18th April and Fri 27th April (10hrs).</u>

English – Mrs Wade will be holding revision/catch up sessions on Monday afternoons, 3-4pm in room M2.1. All year 11 students are welcome.

History – Revision every Wednesday afternoon from 3-3.45pm in M1.6 with Mr Martin and every Friday afternoon from 3-4pm in M3.3 with Miss Hutchings. French and Spanish – Every Friday 3-4pm in language classrooms. Specific Spanish revision is held on Mondays from 3-4pm in M1.3. Students should be writing, practising and learning their answers to the speaking exam questions. The speaking exam will be held on Monday 30th April. Don't forget to use Duolinguo or Memrise to help you revise.

PE – The VCert re-sit exam will be held on Tuesday 13th March.

Maths – We have launched a new revision website called 'Hegarty Maths'. Please ask your daughter about it. If you'd like more information please contact a member of the maths department.

Science – All year 11 students should have access to Tassomai, an online revision resource which can be accessed on a phone, tablet or PC. They should be completin activities on this app for at least 15-20 minutes each day. If you've got any queries about using Tassomai please see Mrs Evans.

Music – The deadline for all music coursework is Wednesday 28th March. This includes compositions with programme notes and a solo and ensemble performance. Music revision is held every Friday in the 'big' music room, 3-4pm. The best revision guide for music is the 'CGP GCSE AQA Music 9-1' guide.
