Dear Parents/Carers

I am writing to provide an update on provision for childcare in Magna Learning Partnership Schools for May. Having amalgamated our provision in our Hub for the recent period of lockdown, we now believe it is time to take a different approach which (hopefully) anticipates the re-opening of our schools for more pupils and students after the half term break. We will, of course wait for government guidance on how this will happen.

From next week we are running **provision in each of the schools**. Please note that **priority is given to the children of critical workers and to vulnerable children**. The provision for the three weeks beginning Monday 4<sup>th</sup> May (including the bank holiday on Friday 8<sup>th</sup> May) and concluding on Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> May will be offered by your child's home school. For the week beginning Monday 26<sup>th</sup> May and including that bank holiday we will run a holiday programme at Sarum Academy. The other schools will be closed.

The advice from the government remains: If children can stay safely at home, they should, to limit the chance of the virus spreading.

If you need your child to attend their school on one or more days next week please email the member of staff co-ordinating provision at your child's school by 6pm on the day before you need childcare. Contact details are as follows:

You will need to provide the following information:

1. Your child's name and year group
2. Your name, email and phone number
3. Necessary detail about your child e.g. medical needs, EHCP, receiving support from social care
4. Which days provision is required

Your child will need to bring with them work and activities to complete and also a packed lunch and a drink. Please note that this will be supervision not teaching, that social distancing guidelines will be in operation for both children and adults and that the provision for first aid and other support will be limited because of social distancing. You will need to be easily contactable should there be an issue with your child.
